

# ALFA Walk

Distance: approx. 4km

Time: approx. 1 hour

The route crosses fields with uneven ground, with horses roaming and some steps. Sturdy footwear is recommended. The walk can be done in reverse.

Key:

Purple – public footpaths

Red – BE1 and HEL341 site boundaries

Blue – suggested walk route

The walk starts on Allum Lane at the top of the road leading to the Recycling Centre. (see photo)

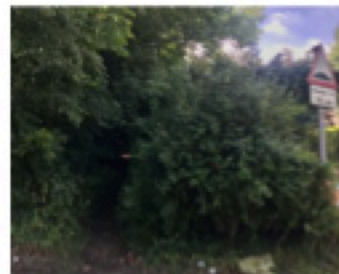
Take the pathway off to the right through trees.

At crossroads go straight ahead.

You will see the cemetery on your left and fields (Site HEL341) on your right.

Pass a playground on your left.

When you reach the War Memorial turn left onto High Street.



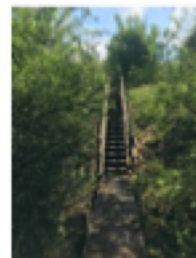
Walk along High Street until you reach a public footpath sign on the left. The turn is also signposted for Elstree Cottage and Hill House Care Home (see photo).

Turn left and follow path up the road, past houses and gardens, then St Nicholas school playground on your left.

The path turns right and brings you onto Barnet Lane.

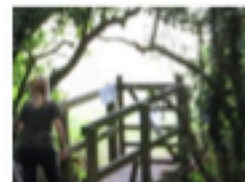


Turn left onto Barnet Lane and follow the pavement until you see a public footpath sign on your left – just before the sign for 16 luxury flats. Turn left and follow the path through trees until you reach a building development on your right. Follow the path that bears right through woods, and keeping the building development on your right, until you reach some steps (see photo).



At the top of the steps turn left through woodland, looking out for wild flowers and deer.

Follow the path straight ahead until you reach a gate leading into a field (see photo).



Go straight ahead through this field that will probably contain horses.

You are now walking through Site BE1.

You will reach another gate (see photo)

Walk straight through this gate, across the field heading for a pathway to the left following the left boundary.



Continue along this path until you reach another gate (see photo).

Exit the field via this gate and walk straight ahead to Allum Lane where you end your walk.
